

Relationship between Celsius and Fahrenheit

In the metric system, degrees Celsius are used rather than degrees Fahrenheit. One degree Celsius is equivalent to 1.8 degrees Fahrenheit.



Some notes on the Temperature scale:

Both the Celsius and Fahrenheit scales read the same at -40°

 $0^{\circ}F$ was determined using a mixture of ice and salt. It was thought, at the time, it was the lowest temperature that could be reached.

Body temperature varies over the course of a day depending on activity and nourishment.
